**CENTER FOR SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT**

“The CSD” strives to nurture the spiritual lives of all who seek God. It serves as a sacred epicenter responding to spiritual needs of local and global communities of faith. Spiritual direction, retreats and programs, meeting space and more are offered.

**CSJ EDUCATIONAL NETWORK** Extends the teaching ministry of Jesus in the tradition of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Orange by empowering school leaders to form students as proactive instruments of unity and reconciliation in the Church and global society.

**SISTERS OF ST. JOSEPH HEALTHCARE FOUNDATION** Our Healthcare Foundation provides grants to address critical needs in California with an emphasis on food security, housing security, and family violence prevention.

**ST. JOSEPH JUSTICE CENTER** The St. Joseph Justice Center energizes and empowers people to be agents of change through advocacy, consciousness raising, prayer, action, and direct services.

**ST. JOSEPH WORKER PROGRAM** The St. Joseph Worker Program creates a year-long service opportunity for women in preparation for a life-long commitment to social change and personal transformation.

**OFF-CAMPUS MINISTRIES**

**PROVIDENCE ST. JOSEPH HEALTH** Hospitals founded and operated by the Sisters of St. Joseph of Orange formed one of the nation’s first health systems. Today, Providence St. Joseph Health continues the healing ministry of Jesus to the communities they serve, especially those who are poor and vulnerable.

**CSJ CENTER FOR RECONCILIATION AND JUSTICE** The CSJ Center serves faculty, staff, alumni and students of Loyola Marymount University, offering a forum for dialogue, a place of education and a resource for reflective action, encouraging “the service of faith and the promotion of justice” at LMU and beyond.

**CSJ SHELTER FOR REFUGEE FAMILIES** The Sisters of St. Joseph of Orange strive to help our brothers and sisters caught up in forced migration and the confusing processes to legally find a home. We collaborate with faith-based networks to house families at undisclosed locations.

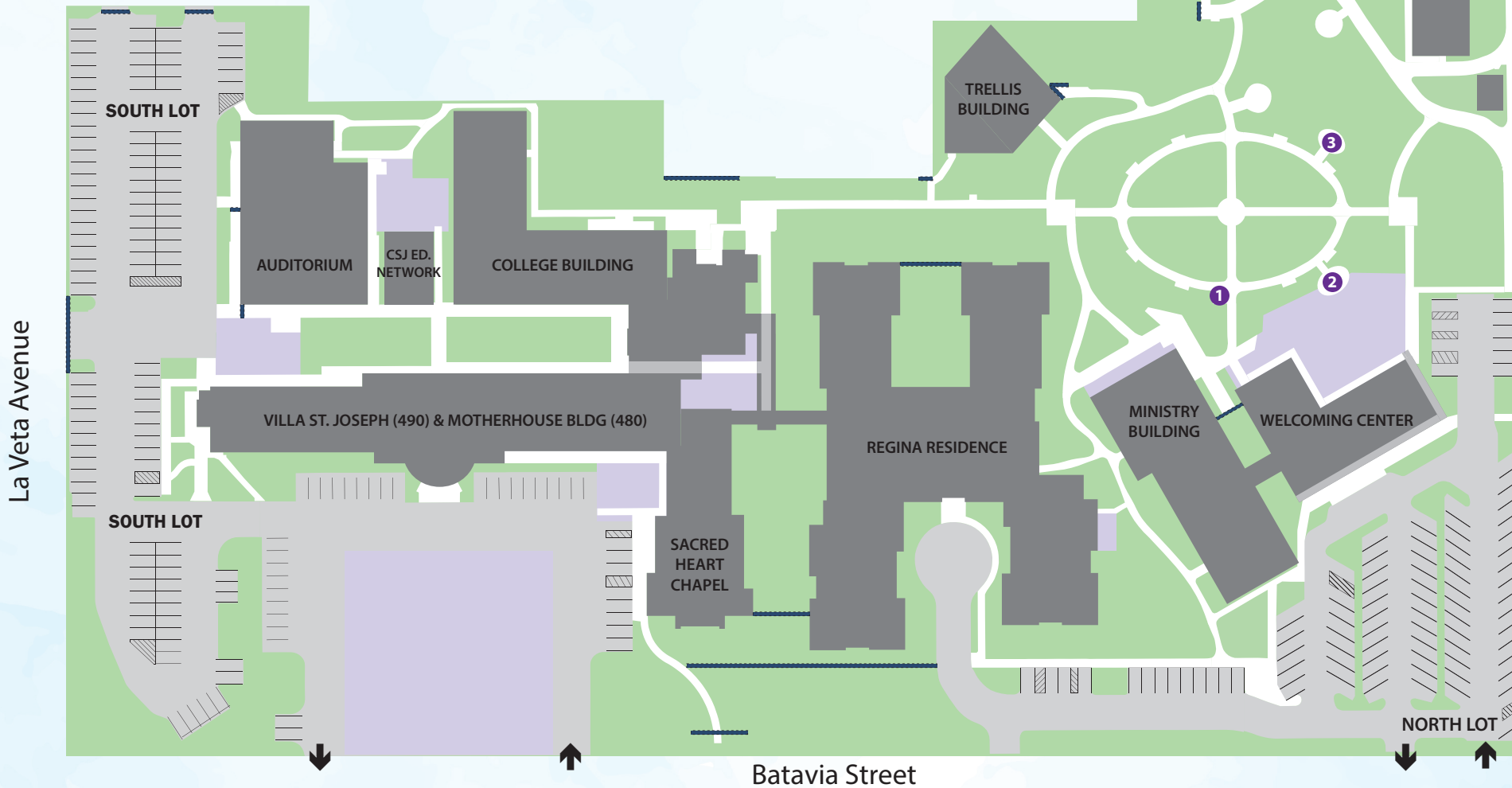

**WELCOMING CENTER** The Welcoming Center serves as the “front door” reception for the Sisters of St. Joseph of Orange, and is the location of its Heritage Room.

**MINISTRY BUILDING** Offices for leadership, administration, finance, ministries, and more.

**REGINA RESIDENCE** A retirement and care community for the Sisters of St. Joseph of Orange and additional religious communities.

**SACRED HEART CHAPEL** Sacred Heart Chapel offers Mass weekdays at 11 am and Sundays at 9 am. Schedule changes and additional services may occur.

**MOTHERHOUSE & VILLA ST. JOSEPH** Once a residence for many Sisters, the Motherhouse Building was renovated in 2024 and is home to Villa St. Joseph, an affordable housing community for seniors operated by Mercy Housing. Sisters continue to use part of the building for Archives and offices.

**AUDITORIUM** This 500-seat venue continues to host performances and meetings.

**COLLEGE BUILDING** Once the home of St. Joseph College, this building is utilized by the University of San Francisco as its Orange County Campus. The building also holds the campus kitchen, St. Joseph Library, Mother Louis Room, and other meeting spaces and offices.

**SPIRITUALITY BUILDING** This tranquil meeting space on the west side of the St. Joseph Center Garden is home to the Center for Spiritual Development and Loyola Institute for Spirituality.

**ST. JOSEPH CENTER GARDEN** The Garden is a large open space in the center of the north side of the campus. Here, one can connect with the beauty of God’s creation.
