Results of the Poll to support the CALIFORNIA BILATERAL NUCLEAR WEAPONS FREEZE INITIATIVE:

155 Sisters support the Congregation taking a stand in favor of the initiative.

7 Sisters are not sufficiently informed to take a stand.

2 Sisters oppose taking a stand.

The Congregation may take a Corporate Stand on an issue if in a poll of the entire community at least 80 informed sisters vote in the affirmative and no more than 30 informed sisters articulate a minority position.

Our stand, favoring the initiative, will be communicated to Governor Jerry Brown, President Reagan, Alexander Haig, Caspar Weinberger, Senators Cranston, Hayakawa and other elected members of Congress, as well as Californians for Bilateral Nuclear Weapons Freeze.
